Detention Basin

Maintaining a healthy detention basin is an ongoing project with multiple factors to address. Some of the work is very expensive thus requiring the dues increase being voted upon. These include erosion prevention, cleaning debris from inlets and basin, removing and replacing the proper stones/boulders, planting trees and plants that maintain the correct water level, and mitigating the effects of sump pump drainage into the basin. By-Laws Update

A committee of 5 residents met in February and March, and put together changes to update our By-Laws. Here is a list of proposed changes (these are posted on the website, see sidebar on left):

Article IV -- Board of Directors

Section 1—Change the number of Board positions from 7 to 5.

Article V - - Officers

Section 1—New language is added to address future Board membership.

Section 2—New language is added to the Vice-Presidents responsibilities.

Section 3—Change in Secretary's Title and added responsibility.

Section 4—New language is added for the Treasurer to obtain liability insurance.

Section 5 (New) - Role of this position and its responsibilities are defined.

Article VI - - Committees

Audit Committee Section 2—New language is added.

Audit Committee Section 3—New language is added.

Civic Affairs Committee (Remove)

Parks, Recreation and Grounds Committee

Section 1—New language is added.

Article VII - - Member Meetings

Section 1—Change language for when the 2 semi-annual Association meetings are held.

Article X - - Dues

Article XI -- Insurance and Indemnity (New)

A specific insurance amount is now mentioned.

New language is introduced to indemnify the Board members.

Article XIII - - Special Assessment

Change the maximum amount for any approved Special Assessment.

Section 2 (New) - New language added to provide specificity for a Special Assessment.

Section 3 (New) - New language added for when notice of the need for a Special Assessment is given.

Road Work Update

With the collection of the 1st installment of the Special Assessment behind us, the Road Committee is working to get started on the following:

- Evaluate pavement replacement by April 30.
- Have the rest of the subdivision roads sealed by May 30.
- Depending on availability of Hard Rock Concrete Company, we expect replacement of slabs to happen mid-summer.

During this work, please watch your speed on the roads around the constructions sites.
